If you have faith but no works, you simply cannot demonstrate to another that you have faith. That is the point James is making when he says, "Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works (James 2:18)."

Answer: James says, “For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also” (James 2:26). Faith without works is a dead faith because the lack of works reveals an unchanged life or a spiritually dead heart. There are many verses that say that true saving faith will result in a transformed life, that faith is demonstrated by the works we do.

Jesus said that people would know His followers by their love (John 13:35). In this way we are a light to the world (Matthew 5:14). Good works, then, demonstrate the veracity of our faith and the character of the God in Whom we believe. Faith without works is dead because true faith transforms a life. It is also true that works without faith are dead.

What does it mean that faith without works is dead?

Paul famously writes that “a person is justified by faith apart from the works of the law.” But James writes that “a person is considered righteous by what they do and not by faith alone” and that “faith without works is dead.”

What James means by “Faith without works is dead ...

Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. 19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble! 20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? 21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar?

5. "Faith Without Works Is Dead" (James 2:20) - FairMormon

Dead Faith. James summarizes starkly in verse 17: “So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.”. It is important to note that the formula is not “faith + works = salvation.”. James does not say that works need to be added to faith in order for one to be saved. Instead, his explicit language is that faith either “has” or “does not have” works (v. 17).
