Background We sought to determine whether US Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) Step 1 score, American Board of Surgery (ABS) In-Training Examination (ABSITE) score, and other variables are associated with

failing the ABS qualifying and certifying examinations. Identifying such factors may assist in the early implementation of an academic intervention for at-risk residents.

Predicting Performance on the American Board of Surgery ...

Early stage I, II treated with either XRT or surgery (not both, same outcome) and advanced stage III, IV are treated with combination XRT+surgery (superior outcome compared to either one alone) XRT alone is the best treatment for SCC or BCC of the nose, eye, lip, eyelid, inner and outer canthi with cure rates of 96% (BCC), 92% for SCC.

METHODS: A structured academic curriculum and focused remediation program (FRP) were implemented to improve academic performances. Within a 15-year period, ABSITE and American Board of Surgery qualifying exam (ABS QE) results were compared before and after the establishment of the program using a paired T-test.
