Alternate interior angles are equal ($a^\circ = z^\circ$, $b^\circ = y^\circ$, $c^\circ = w^\circ$, $d^\circ = x^\circ$) and all acute angles ($a^\circ = c^\circ = w^\circ = z^\circ$) and all obtuse angles ($b^\circ = d^\circ = x^\circ = y^\circ$) equal each other. Same-side interior angles are supplementary and add up to 180° (e.g. $a^\circ + d^\circ = 180^\circ$, $d^\circ + c^\circ = 180^\circ$).
