Cartridge fuses fit inside a fuse block that inserts into a slot in the fuse box. Removing them involves extracting the fuse block by pulling on a handle, then replacing individual fuses in the block. They are generally found in pairs inside the fuse block—each one controlling 120-volts of the combined 240-volt service.
