Charles Lewis Camp was born in Jamestown, North Dakota, on March 12, 1893, of pioneer stock from whom he inherited the vigor and rugged independence which were among his outstanding characteristics. His family moved to Sierra Madre in southern California in 1895 where he attended Throop Academy in Pasadena.
