### Federal Courts Jurisdiction And Venue

"Jurisdiction" means that a court has the power to exercise authority over all persons and things within its territory. To properly file a lawsuit, you must file the lawsuit in a court that has jurisdiction. "Venue" is the geographical location of a particular court. To properly file a lawsuit, you must file the case in an appropriate venue. There are two ways a lawsuit may end up in federal court. First, a case may be filed in the federal court directly.

### Federal Court: Jurisdiction and Venue Defined

Jurisdiction and Venue. Before you file a lawsuit, you will want to make sure that you are filing in a court that has the authority to hear the case. This concept is known as jurisdiction, and it consists of two main parts. The court must have power over the defendant that you are suing, which is known as personal jurisdiction, and it must have the power to resolve the legal issues in the case, which is known as subject matter jurisdiction.

The act contains significant revisions in the areas of removal of cases to federal court and venue, and less important changes in jurisdiction and transfer of cases.

The Federal Courts Jurisdiction and Venue Clarification Act (the "Act") changes the treatment of resident aliens, meaning aliens "admitted to the United States for permanent residence," for diversity jurisdiction purposes, effectively closing the federal courthouse doors to disputes between aliens whether permanent residents or not.

### Federal Court Jurisdiction, Venue, And Removal ...

Federal courts have jurisdiction over matters involving controversies between the states, questions of federal law, and controversies between parties from different states in which the amount involved exceeds \$50,000. Other matters are limited to jurisdiction at the state court level.

### Jurisdiction and Venue: Selecting the Right Court

Some district courts have found clauses mandating venue in a county with no federal courthouse (or providing that venue "shall be" such a county) as ambiguous and have construed them to allow venue in the federal district court that includes that county, even if that federal court is located elsewhere. 12 In 2009, a district court in the ...

### Venue-selection Clauses: A Trap for the Unwary - The ...

Venue and jurisdiction are separate concepts. Just because a plaintiff files a case in the correct venue does not mean that the court has jurisdiction over the parties or the subject matter, and vice versa. Jurisdiction refers to a federal court's "power to adjudicate." Venue doesn't deal with that.

### Jurisdiction and Venue - New CAED - United States Courts

In a civil case (a dispute between two parties), venue is determined by where the parties live or where the original dispute arose.
