Good medical practice describes what it means to be a good doctor. It says that as a good doctor you will: make the care of your patient your first concern. be competent and keep your professional knowledge and skills up to date. take prompt action if you think patient safety is being compromised.

Maintaining trust Be honest and open and act with integrity. Never discriminate unfairly against patients or colleagues. Never abuse your patients' trust in you or the public's trust in the profession.

Duties of a doctor - GMC

You must provide a good standard of practice and care. If you assess, diagnose or treat patients, you must: adequately assess the patient's conditions, taking account of their history (including the symptoms and psychological, spiritual, social and cultural factors), their views and values; where necessary, examine the patient

How Good Medical Practiceapplies to you ■■ For medical students, Good Medical Practice identifies the basic duties of a good doctor and serves as a source of education and reflection. ■■ For doctors, Good Medical Practice serves as a basis for you to monitor, and reflect on, your own conduct and that of your colleagues.
