Under Hong Kong's Basic Law, the local government had responsibility to legislate for national security in the territory (under Article 23). The nearest that Hong Kong came to achieving this was in 2002, when former Secretary for Security Regina Ip sought to implement a much harsher law that addressed six types of conduct.
