In the search box on the taskbar, type restore files, and then select Restore your files with File History. Look for the file you need, then use the arrows to see all its versions. When you find the version you want, select Restore to save it in its original location.

to the older one with the Windows.old folder. Go to "Settings > Update & Security > Recovery", you'll see a "Get Started" button under "Go back to Windows 7/8.1/10. Click it and Windows will restore your old Windows operating system from the Windows.old folder.

Not only that, but it can also take a similar snapshot prior to any system update so you can revert to the pre-update version easily too.
