Chapter 19 of the 2016 edition of the ICD-10-CM contains ICD codes that cover injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes, in the code range S00-T88. Code Range. Section Description. S00-S09.

ICD-10-CM Chapter 19

In general, the ICD-10-CM code set provides greater specificity than ICD-9-CM, and this is true for the coding of injuries as well. The fundamental guidelines for coding injuries in ICD-10 remain the same as ICD-9, but ICD-10 does include some new features including seventh character extensions. Chapter 19 contains 57% of the total volume of codes available, making it the largest chapter.

How to use Chapter 19 (Injuries, Poisonings, etc) in ICD-10-CM

Chapter 19 Injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes. Note: Use secondary code (s) from Chapter 20, External causes of morbidity, to indicate cause of injury. Codes within the T section that include the external cause do not require an additional external cause code. The chapter uses the S-section for coding different types of injuries related to single body regions and the T-section to cover injuries to unspecified body regions as well as poisoning and certain other ...

The seventh character under ICD-10 defines the "type of encounter". As I mentioned in my earlier article, sensibly and tactfully preparing for ICD-10 can be achieved successfully with a high level of transparency. Certain ICD-10-CM categories have applicable seventh characters. Chapter 19 - "Injury, poisoning, and certain other consequences of external cause" require a 7 th character, or as notes in the tabular list instruct. The seventh character also must always be the seventh ...

CHAPTER SPECIFIC CATEGORY CODE BLOCKS. • S00-S09 Injuries to the head. • S10-S19 Injuries to the neck. • S20-S29 Injuries to the thorax. • S30-S39 Injuries to the abdomen, lower back, lumbar spine, pelvis and external genitals. • S40-S49 Injuries to the shoulder and upper arm.

This article will continue that theme by reviewing changes we will encounter in ICD-10-CM's Chapter 19: Injury, Poisoning & Certain Other Consequences of External Causes. In the 2012 fiscal-year version of ICD-9-CM, the code range for Chapter 19 is 800-999, a grouping that consists of 2,587 codes. Compare this to the same year's version of ICD-10-CM, where Chapter 19's code range is S00-T98, a grouping that consists of 39,869 codes.
