OTDA Home Programs & Services Home Energy Assistance Program. Overview. The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps low-income people pay the cost of heating their homes. If you are eligible, you may receive one regular HEAP benefit per program year and could also be eligible for emergency HEAP benefits if you are in danger of running out of fuel or having your utility service shut off.

The HEAP income limits are published on the New York Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance website. Households are only eligible if the income falls below the specified limits based on the household size. For example, 2014-2015 guidelines limit a family of three to a monthly gross income of \$3,544. A family of four can't exceed \$4,219 a month.

2020-2021 Federal Income Guidelines - New York State ...

Income guidelines, maximum income eligibility for the New York State Home Energy Assistance Program is set at the higher of 60% of the State Median Income or 150% of the Federal Poverty Level. Estimated Funding Allocation, 2604(C), 2605(k)(1), 2605(b)(9), 2605(b)(16) - Assurances 9 and 16

Draft 2020-2021 Home Energy Assistance Program State Plan

Last Stop will help low- and moderate-income individuals who have trouble paying for heating but don't meet income guidelines for the federal Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP). Applicants must first have applied for HEAP and been rejected. They should be within \$250 of the HEAP maximum income and not have more than \$2,500 in on-hand assets.

New York State Electricity and Gas | The LIHEAP Clearinghouse

There are no resource eligibility criteria for Regular HEAP. Regular benefit amounts range from \$20 to \$500. Amounts depend on income, age of household members, energy costs and shelter situation. Typically it is a one-time only benefit during the program year.

EmPower New York Eligibility Guidelines. Homeowners and renters must meet income requirements to qualify for EmPower New York. You may be eligible if you can answer "yes" to these statements: I live in a home or building with 100 units or fewer. My household income is below 60 percent of the state median income (same eligibility as regular HEAP benefits; see the chart below to see if your income fits EmPower New York Guidelines)

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) can help eligible New Yorkers heat their home. The amount of assistance depends on your household income and may be available even if your heat is included in your rent.

The HEAP CAC provides air conditioners and fans to eligible households. Benefits are not to exceed \$800 per household, including the cost of an air conditioner, administrative costs, labor, program support, materials, removal of the old unit, and minor repairs essential for safe installation. Funds may not be used for any other purpose.

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is a federally funded program, which is administered by New York State to assist low-income families with their energy needs. Multiple components are available to apply for heating assistance or services while the funding is available.

HEAP (Home Energy Assistance Program)

HEAP is a one-time grant that is paid in two forms, basic and emergency. Basic is paid to all income eligible households that meet the criteria under the Income Guidelines for HEAP. Emergency is paid to all income eligible households that also meet the criteria on the Income Guidelines for HEAP and have a shut off notice or low fuel. However ...

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) Overview

For 2020-2021, the income levels are: For households with more than eight (8) members, add \$7,840 for each additional member. A household applying for HEAP must report total gross household income for the past 30 days (12 months preferred) for all members, except wage or salary income earned by dependent minors under 18 years old.
