Gifted students don't need to do 25 problems in math when they can do the five most difficult first to demonstrate mastery, says Brulles. Six Strategies for Challenging Gifted Learners

The highly able mathematics student should independently demonstrate the ability to: display mathematical thinking and have a keen awareness for quantitative information in the world around them. think logically and symbolically about quantitative, spatial, and abstract relationships.
