Two Unified Messaging user interfaces are available to Outlook Voice Access users: the telephone user interface (TUI) and the voice user interface (VUI) that uses Automatic Speech Recognition (ASR). Before users can use the VUI in Outlook Voice Access, it must be enabled on the UM dial plan and on the UM mailbox policy and also be enabled for the user.
