For example, according to The Bluebook, Georgia's Official Code of Georgia Annotated should be abbreviated as Ga. Code Ann. According to § 1-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, however, the Georgia code "may be cited or referred to as 'O.C.G.A.'" As such, when practicing in Georgia, it would be correct to cite to O.C.G.A. rather than Ga. Code Ann.
