If we know the greatest common divisor (GCD) of integers a and b, we can calculate the LCM using the following formula. $LCM(a, b) = a \times b / GCD(a, b)$ Using back the same example above, we can find the LCM of 24 and 60 as follows. $LCM(24, 60) = 24 \times 60 / 12 = 120$. Of course, you can use this formula to find GCD of two integers if you already know the LCM.

The GCD or Greatest Common Divisor of two or more integers, which are not all zero, is the largest positive integer that divides each of the integers. GCD is also known as Greatest Common Factor. The least common multiple (LCM) of two numbers is the smallest number (not zero) that is a multiple of both numbers.

The product of two numbers a and b is equal to the product of GCD(a,b) and LCM(a,b). $a*b = GCD(a,b) * LCM(a,b)$ Using this formula we can find GCD and LCM at a time. We need to find either GCD and LCM and then apply this formula. In the below program, we find GCD then the above formula is used to find the LCM. The Formula used for this purpose is: $LCM(a,b) = (a*b) / GCD(a,b)$ The below program finds LCM and GCD of two numbers.

GCD is useful for computing the modular multiplicative inverse. This is used in cryptography; particularly noteworthy is its use in public-key cryptosystems that are used to secure online transactions. Coprime numbers are the numbers whose GCD is equal to 1. The product of LCM and GCD of two numbers is equal to the product of those two numbers.

LCM and GCD Calculator

This C program is to find LCM and GCD/HCF of two numbers. LCM(Least Common Multiple) is the smallest positive number which is divisible by both the numbers. For example lcm of 8 and 12 is 24 as 24 is divisible by both 8(8*3) and 12(12*2). HCF(Highest Common Factor)/GCD(Greatest Common Divisor) is the largest positive integer which divides each of the two numbers. For example gcd of 8 and 12 is 4 as divisors of 8 are 1,2,4,8 and divisors of 12 are 1,2,3,4,12, so the greatest common divisor is 4.

Example: Find GCD of 52 and 36, using Euclidean algorithm. Solution: Divide 52 by 36 and get the remainder, than divide 36 with the remainder from previous step. When the remainder is zero the GCD is the last divisor.
