Using Similes Writers use similes as descriptors. For a comparison poem, the writer might observe something and decide to make an unusual association. For example in his poem "Difference" Mark Doty compares jellyfish in a bay to a "school of clouds;" the simile serves as a commentary of the ephemeral nature of the jellyfish.

A metaphor is a figure of speech that makes a comparison between two things that are usually unlike each other, and it replaces the word for one object with that of another. Unlike a simile which is another figure of speech that utilizes “like” or “as”, a metaphor makes the comparison without the use of ...
