Ultrasound | Oncology Medical Physics

Skin Sparing. MV photons do not reach maximum dose at the surface/skin but build-up to a maximum dose. This effect is referred to as skin sparing and is desirable for most photon treatments.. Depth of Maximum Dose (d max). The depth of maximum dose is closely connected to photon energy but also source-to-surface distance, field size and beam profile.
