Strongyloidiasis is transmitted through direct penetration of human skin by infective larvae when in contact with soil; walking barefoot is therefore a major risk factor for acquiring the infection. *Strongyloides* spp. larvae penetrate the human host and reach the intestine where they mature into adults and produce eggs; the eggs hatch in the gut lumen and yield larvae that are evacuated in faeces.

Blood tests to check for antibodies to *Strongyloides* are also done. (Antibodies are proteins produced by the immune system to help defend the body against attack, including that by parasites.) However, these tests cannot distinguish between new and old infections or sometimes between *Strongyloides* and other roundworm infections.

Heavy *Strongyloides* infections can rarely cause bowel obstruction, and there has been a report linking *S. stercoralis* infection and biliary cancer although this observation requires confirmation. The most important complication of *Strongyloides* is the hyperinfection syndrome that can occur in certain hosts.
