## **Who Was Desiderius Erasmus and What Is the Textus Receptus ...**

It has been proposed that inasmuch as (a) the Greek text of the New Testament was kept pure in the age of the Reformation, as in all other ages, and (b) the Textus Receptus is pure, it follows that other forms of the text – especially in cases where the form of the text is so thoroughly changed as to mean something that the Textus Receptus does not mean – must be corrupt.

Stephanus also edited the Textus Receptus in 1546, 1549, 1550 (Editio Regia), and 1551. Theodore Beza edited the Textus Receptus nine times between 1565 and 1604 . The Authorized Version translators used the 1598 of Beza , a disciple of John

Calvin , who both had access to Waldensian versions and manuscripts.

Erasmus' editions were also the foundation for later Greek editions of the New Testament by others. Among them were the four published by Robert Estienne (Stephanus, 1503-59). The third of these, published by Stephanus in 1550, became the Textus Receptus or Received Text of Britain and the basis for the King James Version.

The Erasmus Textus Receptus was collated and published in 1516. Erasmus had before him a half-dozen manuscripts. Today, unscrupulous critics are quick to seize upon this apparent "flaw" of the Textus Receptus to deride the KJV.

## **Textus Receptus Bibles**

Printings of the Textus Receptus. Erasmus was the author of five published editions from 1516 to 1535, the 1516 edition being the very first Textus Receptus. There were approximately thirty distinct editions of the Textus Receptus made over the years. Each differs very slightly from the others. There have been over 500 printings.

## **History - Textus Receptus Bibles**

For our purposes here, the term textus receptus means the 1550 edition of the Greek New Testament published by Robertus Stephanus. The Westcott and Hort text is much simpler to define. This is the Greek New Testament edited by B. F. Westcott and F. J. A. Hort and first published in 1881, with numerous reprints in the century since.
