In time the tent became a symbol for home and a general term for dwelling, or habitation (skene, Luke 16:9). The Moses Tabernacle was called the "tent of meeting," occurring numerous times in the wilderness record (Exod 26-Num 31; cf. 2 Sam 7:1-11). Tent was used symbolically, with nostalgic recall, long after Israel was settled in Caanan.
