AREA FORECASTS (FA) provide an 18-hour synopsis of expected weather patterns; a 12-hour forecast of VFR cloud cover, weather and visibility; and a 6-hour categorical outlook. FAs are prepared 3 times a day (4 times a day in Alaska and Hawaii) and are supplemented and updated by SIGMETs, AIRMETs, and by FA amendments.
